This includes standard costs targets vs. actual production costs, all costs associated with current products and new product designs, raw materials and manufacturing methods in order to deliver the reporting required on actual costs vs. estimates. Additionally, and as needed, the Sr. Cost Accountant's role will help support the general accounting needs of the organization with financial reporting, variance analysis, capital expenditures, process improvements and assisting with month/year-end close.
